MOT Program-related Expenses Updated August 2025

We have provided estimates of MOT program-related expenses which students may incur during the 2.25 years.

We are a publicly funded program with tuition determined by state residency. Out-of-state residents pay a higher tuition rate because WA State tax dollars go towards reducing the in-state resident tuition.

Health Sciences Immunizations Program (HSIP)	\$20 per quarter
Clinical Placements Northwest (CPNW) account	\$75 annual fee
Med + Proctor account for HSIP	\$24 one-time fee
CastleBranch Criminal Background Checks	\$90.99 initial check, \$26.99 for each recheck
BLS/CPR for Healthcare Providers certification	\$95 for two-year certification

Other Expenses

- · Clinical sites may have additional onboarding requirements
 - o Immunizations and criminal background checks are a student expense
 - Students may have to pay vendor onboarding fees
 - Sites may require students to wear uniforms or scrubs or adhere to a dress code
 - Students pay for expenses related to travel or temporary residence for out of area fieldwork placements
- Students are required to have a computer or laptop to successfully access programs and online instructional materials used in REHAB courses
 - Computers need to access high speed internet to run videoconferencing software, stream video, access Canvas-the UW learning management system, OneDrive, and required learning activities
- Official UW transcripts cost \$11 per electronic copy
