

## **ESA Certification Process**

Updated March 2023

For graduates of the UW MOT Program the steps to apply for ESA certification in Washington State are:

- 1. Visit the Washington Office of Superintendent of Public Instruction's website for "School Occupational Therapist First Time" <a href="https://www.k12.wa.us/certification/educational-staff-associate-certificates/esa-first-time-applicant/school-occupational-therapist-first-time">https://www.k12.wa.us/certification/educational-staff-associate-certificates/esa-first-time-applicant/school-occupational-therapist-first-time</a>
- 2. Follow the steps to apply for a temporary permit.
- 3. Submit official UW transcripts instead of Form 4099E.
  - a. We understand the language on the OSPI website is confusing. We have verified that the UW MOT coursework meets ESA requirements and that they review official transcripts for that information.
  - b. Form 4099E is for OTs who did not graduate from a program that includes ESA certification coursework.
